VISIT OF MR GORBACHEV

- / 1. I attach the final proof of the agreed programme for the visit of the Gorbachevs, which is now at the printers. I am also enclosing a first draft of the administrative arrangements which has been cleared with the Russians, but which will require some further refinement.
2. Moscow are insisting that the press statement on departure should be delivered from a microphone on the tarmac in order to ensure an adequate press presence. They have ruled out the use of a hotel en route for security reasons and also because this would delay the departure. There is unfortunately no accommodation at South Side which could accommodate more than 40-50 journalists so we have no alternative to the tarmac.
3. We are arranging a visit to South Side at 3.00pm this Saturday so that the Soviet side are fully aware of the noisy peak hour conditions likely to occur at the time of Mr Gorbachev's departure at 3.00pm. With the help of powerful loudspeakers on the press stands, however, it should be possible on past experience for the press to hear the statements without too much difficulty.
