The latter sets out in detail the ceremonial for the various events on the programme. If however there are any points on which you would like further clarification, please contact either myself or Clive Almond in Protocol Department. We have made contingency arrangements to use Gatwick or Brize Norton as back-up airports, should Heathrow be closed for any reason. There is still some element of uncertainty regarding the programme for Mr Yakovley in the afternoon following his attendance at the lunch given by the Secretary of State for Defence and the wreathlaying ceremony at Westminster Abbey. He is provisionally down to participate in the factory visit, but this may be judged too tiring on the day. Mr Yakovlev was seriously wounded during the Second World War and as a result cannot walk upstairs and is dependent on lifts. 




