- 1. GRATEFUL IF YOU WOULD PASS THE FOLLOWING MESSAGES FROM THE PRIME MINISTER TO CHANCELLOR KOHL AND THE WIDOW OF ALFRED HERRHAUSEN AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY.
- 2. MESSAGE TO THE WIDOW.

#### BEGINS:

'I WAS DEEPLY SHOCKED AND SADDENED TO LEARN OF THE MURDER OF YOUR HUSBAND THIS MORNING. I VERY MUCH ADMIRED HIM AND HE PLAYED A FOREMOST ROLE IN THE GERMAN AND INTERNATIONAL BANKING COMMUNITY. HIS LOSS WILL BE DEEPLY FELT. MY SYMPATHY IS WITH YOU AT THIS MOST PAINFUL TIME'. ENDS.

3. MESSAGE TO CHANCELLOR KOHL. BEGINS:

'I WAS VERY SHOCKED TO HEAR OF THE DREADFUL MURDER OF ALFRED HERRHAUSEN. HE WAS A VERY WELL KNOWN AND RESPECTED FIGURE IN INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL CIRCLES AND IT HAD BEEN MY PRIVILEGE TO MEET HIM LAST FEBRUARY. THIS APPALLING CRIME UNDERLINES YET AGAIN THE NEED FOR US TO DO ALL WE CAN TO COMBAT TERRORISM. I KNOW THAT THE GERMAN POLICE WILL BE PURSUING THE INVESTIGATION VIGOROUSLY. WE ARE READY TO OFFER YOU ANY ASSISTANCE WE CAN.'
