This decision recognised that in order for research to be commissioned, the ITC may still need to employ a few engineers,

but they would not have an inhouse research facility.

The new proposal from the Home Office is that while part of the existing R&D function is clearly viable, part of it is not. If, however, it were to be restructured in a new business plan, it might conceivably be viable. The Home Secretary suggests that the IBA should be given the chance to restructure before selling. It seems a good idea.

## Recommendation

Support the Home Secretary's proposal.
