



US HELP

- 1. Washington telephoned at 0545. The Ambassador had just spoken to Haig to thank him for the latest message to the Prime Minister, and for the offer of help. Sir N Henderson said we had no specific requests to make at this stage but was confident that the US would strongly condemn the invasion if it took place.
- 2. The Americans had not yet heard whether Archbishop Casaroli (Vatican) had spoken to President Galtieri.
- 3. The Americans have reports (sources not given) that the invasion has been under preparation for three months.
