OPERATION CORPORATE: COMMAND APRANGEMENTS

- 1. Your note MO5/21 dated 5 April 1982 sought my views on the command of the Task Force both afloat and if the Royal Marines go ashore.
- 2. The Commander-in-Chief Fleet has full command of the Task Force. This he exercises from his operational HQ at Northwood where he controls all communications and has access to all available intelligence.
- 3. Operational command of the Force is vested in Flag
 Officer First Flotilla as Combined Commander of the Task Force.
 He in turn will delegate operational control of the Amphibious
 Task Force (the landing ships and their escorts) to
 Commodore Amphibious Warrars. Once the Royal Marines are
 firmly established ashore operational control of the landed
 force would be transferred to Brigade Commander No 3 Commando
 Brigade as Commander Land Forces. Until he lands, the
 Brigade Commander is embarked in HMS FEARLESS with the
 Commodore Amphibious Warfare.
- 4. I am satisfied that this normal and well tried command and control structure for maritime and amphibious operations works well and I see no reason to depart from it at this time.
- 5. The officers presently in command appointments within the Task Force are:

Rear Admiral J F Woodward (Flag Officer First Flotilla)

Commodore M C Clapp (Commodore Amphibious Warfare)

Brigadier J H A Thompson (OC 3 Commando Brigade)

A short CV on each officer is attached. All of these are hav appointments and the officers are carefully selected.

6. Depending on the military operation decided we might consider sending out a 3-star officer, briefed up to date on the political background to join the Task Force via Ascension Island as overall Force Commander.




