MY TELNO 187 AND YOUR TELNOS 71 AND 77: FALKLAND ISLANDS: ECONOMIC MEASURES AGAINST ARGENTINA

I SAW MR TRUDEAU TODAY. HE GAVE ME A LIFT BACK TO HIS HOUSE AFTER HIS CAUCUS MEETING DURING WHICH HE READ CAREFULLY THE PRIME MINISTER'S MESSAGE AND WE THEN DISCUSSED IT AT HIS HOUSE FOR A FEW MINUTES.

- 2. HE SAID THAT THE PRIME MINISTER'S REQUEST WOULD BE STUDIED AT ONCE AND THAT THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT WOULD TRY TO GIVE US A REPLY QUOTE WITHIN HOURS UNQUOTE. HE WOULD ENSURE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS KEPT IN TOUCH WITH ME BUT HE COULD NOT SAY STRAIGHT OFF WHAT CANADA MIGHT DO IN THE ECONOMIC FIELD.
- 3. HE SAID THAT AT THE MINISTERIAL MEETING ON MONDAY HE AND HIS COLLEAGUES HAD CONSIDERED WHAT FORMS OF LEVERAGE THEY MIGHT BE ABLE TO EXERCISE ON THE ARGENTINE. ON THE MAIN ISSUE HE SEEMED TO BE ENTIRELY WITH US AND CLEAR THAT UNPROVOKED AGGRESSION OF THIS SORT COULD NOT BE TOLERATED. HE AGREED THAT IF IT WERE TO BE CONDONED IT COULD LEAD TO ADVENTURES ELSEWHERE. HE QUOTED GIBRALTAR AND HONG KONG. BUT HE WAS INCLINED TO BE SCEPTICAL ABOUT WHETHER ECONOMIC SANCTIONS WOULD DO VERY MUCH TO HELP ACHIEVE OUR OBJECTIVE. I STRESSED THAT IF WE WERE TO AVOID HAVING TO USE FORCE, WHICH OF COURSE WE HOPED NOT TO HAVE TO DO, THE ONLY PROSPECT OF SECURING AN ARGENTINE WITHDRAWAL WAS TO MOBILISE OVERWHELMING PRESSURE FROM MAJOR COUNTRIES. I SAID WE WERE GRATEFUL FOR THE STEPS THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT HAD SO FAR ANNOUNCED AND HEARTENED BY THE IMANIMOUS VOTE OF THE CANADIAN HOUSE OF COMMONS CONDEMNING THE ARGENTINE INVASION BUT THAT FURTHER STEPS WERE NEEDED URGENTLY TO PUT PRESSURE ON THE ARGENTINE. HOWEVER SLIM THE CHANCES MIGHT BE OF GETTING THEM TO PULL OUT, IT WAS IN ALL OUR INTERESTS THAT WE SHOULD DO OUR UTMOST TO BRING THIS ABOUT.

MR TRUDEAU THOUGHT THAT THE DENIAL OF EXPORT CREDIT MIGHT NOT BE TOO DIFFICULT BUT THAT PROBABLY ARGENTINA OWED CANADA MUCH MORE THAN CANADA OWED ARGENTINA AND THAT A TRADE BAN MIGHT SIMPLY LEAD TO ARGENTINA REPUDIATING DEBTS TO CANADA AND EXPROPRIATING ASSETS SO THAT THEY MIGHT BE TEMPORARILY BETTER OFF.

5. MR TRUDEAU LEAVES TONIGHT FOR JAMAICA AND EXPECTS TO BE AWAY ABOUT 4 DAYS.
