Today, millions of Argentines are gathered together in this Plaza de Mayo as well as in plazas throughout the country to ask the same question.

Circumstances have made me President of the nation and so I am here representing all of you. You may all be deeply sure that I have represented all Argentines and that with pride and satisfaction that in our first meeting with representatives of the U.S. government (some boos and whistles) we have maintained the dignity and honor of Argentina which cannot be negotiated by anyone.

The government of Great Britain, Mrs. Thatcher, and the people of Great Britain (prolonged boos) have yet to hear a single word impugning their honor and reputation -- until now. But now, as President of this nation I ask the government and people of Great Britain for moderation in their words and in their deeds. The government and people of Argentina, gathered in this town meeting, are beginning to feel deep emotions because of offensive words from their adversary.

Gathered together here are workers, businessmen, intellectuals, everybody in a spirit of national unity in the search for welfare and dignity.
