CAS REQUIRING EVACUATION APPROX SEVEN HUNDRED OR ONE HUNDRED PER DAY OVER SEVEN DAY PERIOD. OF THIS DAILY TOTAL FORTY PER CENT EST AS PRIOR ONE AND TWO. SIXTY PER CENT PRIOR THREE. AFTER INITIAL SEVEN DAYS EST THAT CAS RATES WOULD REDUCE.

2. YOU SHOULD NOW MAKE APPROPRIATE PLANS FOR CASEVAC AS IN REF. YOU MAY ALSO PLAN FOR A FIFTY BED HOSPITAL TO BE PROVIDED BY THE ARMY DEPT AND TO BE LOCATED AT ASCENSION TO ASSIST AEROMEDICAL EVACUATION.

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
