- 1. I HAVE PASSED ON YOUR LATEST MESSAGE TO HAIG VIA EAGLEBURGER AND HAD A WORD WITH HIM TO EMPHASISE THE DANGER THAT COULD ARISE IF IT APPEARS THAT IT IS US RATHER THAN THE ARGENTINES, WHO ARE BEING PUT ON THE SPOT.
- 2. EAGLEBURGER SAID THAT HE ENTIRELY UNDERSTOOD, HE WOULD SPEAK TO HAIG ON THE TELEPHONE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
- 3. I SAID HE MUST UNDERSTAND THAT THERE WAS EXTREMELY STRONG OPINION IN THE UK ON THIS ISSUE. WE COULD NOT BE FACED ON A TAKE IT OR LEAVE IT BASIS WITH SOMETHING PUT TO US BY HAIG AS THE MAXIMUM OBTAINABLE FROM THE ARGENTINES.
- 4. EAGLEBURGER AGAIN EXPRESSED HIS COMPLETE UNDERSTANDING FOR OUR POINT OF VIEW ON THIS.
- 5. I WILL TRY TO SPEAK TO CLARK LATER THIS MORNING.
