SCR 502 AND ARGENTINE MILITARY ACTION

1. I attach a timetable we have drawn up showing timings of the Argentine invasion of the Falklands and South Georgia and the tabling and passage of our draft Security Council Resolution. The South Georgia timings are derived on MOD debriefing of the returned marines. From this it is clear that although we dealed not know that South Georgia had fallen until many hours after the passage of Resolution 502, South Georgia had in fact fallen several hours before the Resolution was adopted.

2. In the circumstances, I think the Supplementary I submitted this morning on the question whether the UK is in violation of paragraph 1 and Resolution 502 should be shortened by the omission of the second and third sentences. I attach a copy of the Supplementary with these changes made. The main point of the Supplementary is of course unaffected.
