FALKLANDS : FRENCH POSITION 1. IN A RADIO INTERVIEW THIS MORNING (4 MAY) CHANDERNAGOR, THE MINISTER FOR EUROPEAN COMMUNITY MATTERS IN THE QUAL D'ORSAY, RECALLED THAT FROM THE BEGINNING OF THE FALKLANDS CRISIS FRANCE HAD SAID THAT IT WAS INTOLERABLE FOR A COUNTRY TO TAKE THE LAW INTO ITS OWN HANDS AS ARGENTINA HAD DONE. HE THEN WENT ON TO SAY THAT THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT DEEPLY REGRETTED THAT THE CRISIS SHOULD HAVE DEGENERATED INTO A WAR WITH VIOLENCE AND BLOODSHED. NOTING THAT FRANCE HAD NEVER TAKEN UP A POSITION ON THE SUBSTANCE OF THE DISPUTE BETWEEN ARGENTINA AND BRITAIN, CHANDERNAGOR SAID THAT "AN END MUST BE PUT AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE TO THE FALKLANDS CONFLICT AND DISCUSSIONS AND NEGOTIATIONS MUST BE RESUMED. THAT IS THE DIRECTION IN WHICH FRANCE WILL WORK' .. CHANDERNAGOR RECALLED THAT THERE HAD BEEN NEGOTIATIONSGOING ON FOR A LONG TIME "WHICH COULD BE CONTINUED UNDER THE AUSPICES OF SOME BODY OR OTHER, ESPECIALLY THE UNITED NATIONS". HE ADDED THAT FRANCE WOULD DISCUSS THIS MATTER WITH BRITAIN BILATERALLY AND IN THE
