IRAN/IRAQ AND SHIPPING IN THE GULF

PLEASE PASS THE FOLLOWING MESSAGE AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE TO PRESIDENT REAGAN FROM THE PRIME MINISTER:

DEAR ROM

THANK YOU FOR YOUR MESSAGE OF 29 JUNE ABOUT ACTION AT THE UN AIMED AT ENDING THE CONFLICT BETWEEN IRAN AND IRAQ.

THERE SEEMS A GOOD CHANCE THAT THE SECURITY COUNCIL WILL BE READY TO ADOPT A MANDATORY RESOLUTION SOON. WE ARE CERTAINLY READY TO VOTE FOR SUCH A RESOLUTION AS SOON AS IT IS TABLED. I AGREE THAT MORE WORK IS NEEDED BY THE FIVE PERMANENT MEMBERS ON ACTION TO BE TAKEN IN THE EVENT OF NON-COMPLIANCE BY ONE OR OTHER OF THE PARTIES. WE SHALL SUPPORT AN ARMS EMBARGO IF OTHERS DO, ALTHOUGH THERE IS STILL A GOOD DEAL OF WORK TO BE DOME ON DETAILS.

WE MUST ALSO FIND A WAY TO TACKLE ONE OF THE IMMEDIATE CAUSES OF THE ESCALATION IN THE SHIPPING WAR, WHICH IS IRAQI AIR ATTACKS ON IRANIAN TANKERS. THE IRAQIS WILL INEVITABLY BE RELUCTANT TO CUT BACK ON THESE. WE WOULD BE ASKING THEM TO GIVE UP A

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MEAN OF PURSUING THE WAR IN WHICH THEY ENJOY THE ADVANTAGE.
HOWEVER, IF IRAQI ATTACKS WERE STOPPED OR REDUCED, THE IRANIANS
WOULD BE DEPRIVED OF MUCH OF THEIR RATIONALE FOR ATTACKING
FOREIGN SHIPPING, ESPECIALLY THAT BOUND TO KUWAIT. AND THE
FACT IS THAT OPEC QUOTAS ARE MORE EFFECTIVE THAN IRAQI ATTACKS
IN RESTRICTING IRANIAN OIL PRODUCTION. IRAQ WOULD STILL
OF COURSE BETAIN THE OPTION OF ATTACKING ECONOMIC TARGETS INSIDE
IRAN.

I DO NOT UNDERESTIMATE THE DIFFICULTIES OF THIS APPROACH, FOR WHICH WE WOULD NEED TO ENLIST THE SUPPORT OF OUR ARAB FRIENDS. BUT IT OFFERS A POTENTIALLY IMPORTANT WAY OF REDUCING THE RISK OF OTHERS BEING DRAWN INTO A DIRECT CONFRONTATION WITH IRAN AND I THINK IT WORTH A TRY. MAY I STRESS THAT THIS IS NOT IN ANY WAY INTENDED TO CUT ACROSS OF UNDERHINE PROGRESS TOWARDS A MANDATORY RESOLUTION AT THE UN.

I LOOK FORWARD VERY MUCH TO DISCUSSING ALL THIS IN GREATER DETAIL WHEN WE HEET ON 17 JULY.
