2. OVER THE COURSE OF ALMOST FOUR YEARS I HAVE ATTENDED
COUNTLESS MEETINGS WITH THE PRIME MINISTER AND MEMBERS
OF THE ADMINISTRATION WHO WERE IN LONDON. I CANNOT
RECALL A BETTER OR MORE CONSTRUCTIVE EXCHANGE THAT THE
ONE DURING THE COURSE OF YOUR MEETING ON MONDAY, JULY 6
(REPORTED SEPTEL).

3. PROFESSOR BRIAN GRIFFITHS, THE PM'S ADVISER ON
EDUCATION, CALLED ME TO EXPRESS HIS ENTHUSIASM AND
APPRECIATION. THE RT. HON. KENNETH BAKER, M.P.,
SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EDUCATION AND SCIENCE ALSO
CALLED, STATING "IT WAS ONE OF THE MOST MEMORABLE
(VISITS) I EVER EXPERIENCED."

4. CHARLES POWELL, THE PM'S PRIVATE SECRETARY, MADE
SIMILAR COMMENTS. IT WAS PERFECTLY CLEAR TO ME THAT THE
PM WAS ENORMOUSLY INTERESTED IN WHAT YOU HAD TO SAY. IN
SHORT, YOUR VISIT WAS A HUGE SUCCESS AND, I BELIEVE,
