

INTELLIGENCE BRIEFING FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE

1. The Secretary of State told me this morning that he would like to see a map each day on which our latest intelligence of Argentine naval dispositions had been marked. I have arranged with DCDS(I) that a map, similar to the one prepared daily for the Chief of Defence Staff, will be sent over to the Foreign Office at 8.00am each morning until further notice. The messenger will ask for the Emergency Unit (6177) and I would be grateful if arrangements could be made for the map to be collected. It will be in a package addressed personally to myself, since it contains highly classified material. In my absence, I suggest that it should be given to Mr Gillmore or Mr Weston, so that we can arrange with the Private Office for an appropriate time to show it to the Secretary of State.

2. The Ministry of Defence have asked if the Emergency Unit could please ensure, as from 11 April, that the previous day's map is given back to the messenger each morning. It should be sealed in a package addressed to General Sir James Glover DCDS(I).
