YOUR TELNO 59: PRINCESS ALEXANDRA

- 1. I AM TODAY SEEING THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE PRESIDENCY, THE MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR AND SHALL SPEAK ALSO TO THE FOREIGN MINISTER WITH WHOM I AM CONSTANTLY IN TOUCH BY TELEPHONE. I SHALL TELEGRAPH MY RECOMMENDATIONS THIS EVENING.
- 2. I SPOKE EARLIER TO THE FOREIGN MINISTER TO CONVEY THE MESSAGE IN PARAGRAPH 2 OF YOUR TUR. HIS OFFICE HAVE NOW ASKED FOR A LETTER CONTAINING THE MESSAGE (WHICH THEY NO DOUBT WISH TO GIVE OUT TO THE LOCAL PRESS) WHICH I HAVE DULY FORWARDED. IT WAS ALSO CONVEYED TO ME THAT BOTH THE PRESIDENT AND THE FOREIGN MINISTER WERE ANXIOUSLY AWAITING A SUBSTANTIVE REPLY. IN AN EARLIER CONVERSATION THE FOREIGN MINISTER ASKED ME IF THERE HAD BEEN ANY RESPONSE TO THE FIRST PERUVIAN PROPOSAL REPORTED IN MY TELNO 74.
- 3. IS THERE NO CHANCE OF HAVING A MORE SUBSTANTIVE MESSAGE ON EITHER OF THEIR TWO PROPOSALS BY THE TIME I SPEAK TO THE FOREIGN MINISTER THIS EVENING? IT IS QUITE CLEAR THAT THE PERUVIANS ATTACH GREATER URGENCY TO THE FALKLAND CRISIS THAN TO ANY OTHER MATTERS WE HAVE IN HAND.
