PERSONAL FOR MINISTER FROM GILLMORE

YOUR TELEGRAM NUMBER 1242: UK REQUEST FOR STINGER

- 1. I REGRET THAT YOUR TUR WAS THE FIRST THAT WE IN THE FCO HAD HEARD OF THIS REQUEST. WE HAVE NOW DISCUSSED THIS WITH THE MOD WHO HAVE ESTABLISHED THE OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR THIS EQUIPMENT. THE HICCOUGH REFERRED TO IN YOUR TUR APPEARS TO HAVE SEMMED FROM THE FACT THAT THE BDS GOT AHEAD OF FINAL CONSIDERATION HERE BY C IN C FLEET ABOUT THE NEED FOR THIS EQUIPMENT.
- 2. THIS PROBLEM NOW HAVING BEEN CLEARED UP, WE HAVE AGREED THAT BDS WASHINGTON SHOULD PURSUE IT URGENTLY WITH THE AMERICANS. MOD WILL BE INSTRUCTING BDS IN THIS SENSE THIS EVENING. GRATEFUL IF YOU WOULD KEEP IN TOUCH WITH THE DEFENCE STAFF TO GIVE THEM WHAT SUPPORT YOU JUDGE NECESSARY IN ACHIEVING US AGREEMENT.
