## COMMENT ON HAIG'S VALEDICTORY STATEMENT

- 1. As requested, I submit some draft points which we might make on the record in response to the statement which Mr Haig is expected to make at Heathrow before his departure.
- 2. The draft assumes that Mr Haig will refer to the difficulties into which the talks have run; to some new ideas to meet these difficulties, and to his intention to return meanwhile to Washington to report to President Reagan.
- 3. The actual text of Mr Haig's remarks will be submitted as soon as we have them.
- 4. In order to avoid anticipating the Prime Minister's report to the House, I suggest that these points might be made by News Department rather than specifically by the Secretary of State.
