1. INT. GENERAL.

A BRZILIAN NAVAL EXERCISE IS TAKING PLACE IN THE WATERS OFF BRAZIL. THIS WAS SHCEDULED SOME TIME AGO AND IS NOT RELATED TO THE PRESENT CRISIS

2. FALKLAND ISLANDS ADMINISTRATION. MIL ADMIN OF FALKLAND ISLANDS HAS BEEN SET UP UNDER GOVERNOR MENENDEZ WITH MIL OFFICERS HOLDING SUCH POSTS AS ECONOMY, PUBLIC WORKS, COMMUNICATIONS, EDUCATION AND SOCIAL SECURITY. A GROUP OF 31 PEOPLE FROM FI WHO ARRIVED MOTEVIDEO 13 APR REPORT THAT MORALE OF ARGENTINIAN TROOPS THEY SAW WAS LOW. IN CONTRAST THE SPIRITS OF ISLANDERS OUTSIDE OF PORT STANLEY WAS SIAD TO BE EXTREMELY HIGH

3. ARG NAVY. MOST ARGENTINE NAVAL VESSELS REMAIN IN PORT
4. ARG AIR. THE FI GROUP REPORTED THAT NO START HAD BEEN
MADE ON EXTENSIONS TO RUNWAY AT STANLEY BY MORNING OF 13
APR BUT THE DISPERSAL AREA IS BEING EXTENDED. NO FAST JETS

5. ARG ARMY. UP TO 12 APR THE FI GROUP REPORTED THERE HAD SEEN NO ARG DEPLOYMENT AT WEST POINT, FORT HOWARD OR DUNNIES LEAD BUT THERE ARE 120-150 TPS IN SCHOOL AT GOOSEGREEN WITH SOME SOFT VEHICLES. WEAPONS NOTED WERE LYNX ERC 90 ARMOURED CARS WITH 90MM GUNS, 20-30 X 105 MM GUNS AND 12 X 20 MM AAA SINGLE AND DOUBLE BARREL 6. FALKLANDS ISLANDS. THE PARTY WHO LEFT THE FIS LAST MONDAY AND ARE NOW IN MONTEVIDEO INCLUDED THE DEPORTED CHIEF SEC-RETARY, THE CHEIF POLICE OFFICER, THE REGISTRAR GENERAL, TOW RAF SECONDED TECHNICIANS AND ONE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEMBER.F TWO OTHER LEGISTLATIVE COUNCIL MEMBERS HAVE BEEN WARNED THAT THEY ARE POLICTICALLY SUSPECT AND MAY BE DEPORTED IFTHEY DON NOT TOE THE LINE
