- 1. CGS agrees the assumptions set out in paragraph 21 of Reference A. However he would prefer Annexes A and B to be rewritten to show a clear and concise justification for each item together with an assessment of the feasibility of obtaining it in the appropriate timescale. In the case of Annex A the number of ships required should be defined more precisely, and the options for obtaining them compared in terms of costs, manpower, timing and training. Measures in Annex B should be related to the deficiencies in the capability of the force.
- 2. CGS also feels that as there are likely to be similar ground and air requirements, this issue could usefully be examined by the DPS 'A' Team.
