YOUR TEL NO 12 TO BIS BUENOS AIRES: ARGENTIME TRADE SANCTIONS AGAINST UK/OTHER COUNTRIES

1. THE GERMAN EMBASSY IN BURNOS AIRES REPORTED TODAY TO THE MFA
AN ARGENTIME GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCEPENT THAT WITH IMPEDIATE EFFECT
NO MORE IMPORT LICENCES WOULD BE GRANTED TO SUPPLIES FROM EC
COUNTRIES, EXCEPT FOR VITAL GOODS SUCH AS SPARE PARTS AND MEDICAL
SUPPLIES. THE ARSENTIME STATEMENT APPARENTLY CLAIMED THAT ARSENTIMA
WAS ACTING QUOTE ACCORDING TO THE PRINCIPLE OF RECIPROCITY UNQUOTE,
AND WOULD COUNTER POINT FOR POINT ANY TRADE MEASURES TAKEN AGAINST
MER. MFA HAD NO INFORMATION ABOUT WHETHER ARGENTIMA WAS ALSO
TAKING IMPEDIATE ACTION AGAINST AUSTRALIAN, NEW ZEALAND OR
CANADIAN IMPORTS.

2. THE ACTING HEAD OF THE MFA SOUTH AMERICA DEPT (EDERER) SAID THAT ARGENTINA WAS THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC'S THIRD LARGEST WARRET IN LATIN AMERICA AFTER BRAZIL AND NEXICO. TOTAL TWO-WAY TRADE IN EACH-OF 1960 AND 1961 HAD BEEN IN THE ORDER OF DM 3,500 MILLION, GERMAN EXPORTS WERE MOSTLY CHEMICALS, FERTILISERS MACHINERY AND FLANT, AND WERE THEREFORE UNLIKELY TO FALL WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF QUOTE VITAL GOODS UNQUOTE WHICH MIGHT BE EXEMPTED FROM THE IMPORT BAN. EDERER ALSO EXPRESSED CONCERN ADOUT GERMAN INVESTMENT IN AGAINTINA, WHICH STOOD AT DM 970 MILLION IN SEPTEMBER 1961.

HE ADDED HOWEVER, THAT ARGENTINA'S MEASURES WERE UNNELCOME BUT NOT UNEXFECTED. THE FRS HAD NATURALLY FORESEEN THEM WHEN AGREEINS TO TAKE ACTION ON ARGENTINIA IMPORTS.

FCO PLEASE PASS SAVING AND REPEAT TO BIS BUENOS AIRES IF REQUIRED.

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
