Not possible to give an accurate assessment of military position in + around S. Georgia - no int. resources deployed in area, therefore no knowledge of what is happening.

From ENDURANCE we believe 40-50 Arg marines form garrison, but unconfirmed. Arg reports put number as high as 350.

No intel on what orders they have been issued with - Chilean attache in BA believes Arg. prepared to sacrifice garrison, but similar force on S. Shetland have been ordered to resist to the death unless odds are overwhelming.

No intel. on Arg. naval units in area - but doesn't mean there are none.

Mom's thought Arg. might ~~act~~ fire if BRANSFIELD suddenly appeared in the area & wondered any attempt to send her in without agreeing such a move through the Swiss would be fraught with danger.

Lowles was much more non-committal - refused to give an assessment because not enough intel.

Hair advised FCO (G-HQ) that we feel it would be dangerous for B to return to S. Georgia & that in any event we advise strongly against (might precipitate PARADET).
