
- 1. You will recall that at OD(SA)(82) 7th Meeting yesterday it was agreed that in order to increase the military options available it would be sensible to reinforce our Task Group with a further battalion of troops and appropriate additional ships which should if possible include HMS INTREPID.
- The additional troops have been identified as a Battalion Group comprising the 2nd Battalion, The Parachute Regiment plus supporting elements (900 men total) who will be placed on 72 hours notice to move from 0900 hours on 17 April.
- The number of troops plus the freight involved would exceed the capacity of HMS INTREPID. HMS INTREPID accompanied (and delayed) by an LSL could not arrive in the Falkland Islands area until late May. Thus, the possibilities of using either MV NORLAND or a suitable civilian vessel(s) are under investigation.
- 4. I will inform you when suitable movement resources have been identified.



# OP CORPORATE - ADDITIONAL TROOPS

- You will recall that at OD(SA) this morning it was agreed 1. that a further battalion should be deployed to the South Atlantic to meet up with the force already on passage. This will be a Battalion Group formed by the 2nd Battalion the Parachute Regiment and supporting elements (900 men). It will be placed at 72 hours notice to move from 0900 17 April.
- The numbers and freight involved exceed HMS INTREPID's capacity and an accompanying LSL would delay arrival in FI area until late May. A study of using the MV NORLAND has revealed certain problems which are being actively examined. She has not yet been ruled out. However, we are currently investigating other civil shipping to identify suitable ships which could transport the battalion to arrive as soon as possible.
- I will inform you when satisfactory movement resources have been identified.
