ACTION BEFORE MEETING

- 2. In preparation for the meeting if time permits you may care to glance at the Attendance List (FLAG A) and take note of the message from SECCOS (FLAG B) before refreshing your memory of the Presentation script (FLAG C). Note that messages at \underline{FLAG} X have necessitated minor changes to Presentation script.
- 3. Haig's latest message (FLAG F) is perhaps worth reading again together with the exchange of messages at FLAG G between FCO and Washington. It is debatable whether or not the FCS visit to Washington should go ahead as planned at FLAG H. It might be advisable to delay FCS visit until OP PARAQUET is completed. Meanwhile, I suggest we should try our luck at the UN: a strongly worded submission would be bound to fail, but thereafter PARAQUET would appear more justified than ever as a last resort. At that stage FCS should visit Washington.
