BAS PARTIES - SOUTH GEORGIA

1. Dr LAWS telephoned me at 231515A to say:
 - a. BAS Parties reported yesterday evening that they were safe and well.
 - b. They reported nothing of interest and therefore they would seem to be unaware of Op PARAQUAT activities. As is, of course, Dr Laws.
 - c. Dr Laws reported that one of his geophysicists had established that an area on the N.E. coast by Bay of Island would be suitable for a 3000 metre airstrip. He thought it well within the capacity of "a few bulldozers" to produce a runway.
