FALKLAND ISLANDS OD(SA)(82) 24: ANNEX B

1. The Attorney General, in considering this paper yesterday, suggested that Annex B should be improved by small change, adding two phrases.

2. He asked that the last sentence of the first paragraph should be amended to read:

' Any ship and any aircraft whether military or civil which is found within this Zone without due authority from the MOD in London will be regarded as operating in support and will therefore be regarded as hostile and will be liable to be attacked by British Forces'.

3. The changes involved are:

(i) After 'MOD in London', to add 'will be regarded as operating in support and '

(ii) After 'hostile and', to add the words 'will be'

4. The Attorney General asks that this suggested revised wording should be adopted in the further consideration of this text before its issue.

5. Sir I Sinclair will, if opportunity offers, draw this revised revision to the attention of others concerned in the margins of the meeting at Chequers. But meanwhile it is desirable that others closely involved should be aware of it.
