

1. Own Forces.

a. Main events in the FI in the last 48 hours were:

(1) At 301334Q INVINCIBLE reported a contact of 1 x Super Etendard and 2 x A4. Believed one EXOCET missile released but not observed. No hit. 1 x A4 claimed to have been shot down by EXETER SEADART. Etendard believed to have been tanked.

(2) HERMES aircraft on 30 May:

(a) Carried out armed recce over hills North of Stanley. 2 suspected radar positions bombed with no confirmation of their existence.

(b) 2nd Attack. Target helicopters WSW of Stanley. No helicopters - artillery and troops attacked instead. 1 x GR3 hit by SA fire. Fuel lost and aircraft crashed: pilot recovered to HERMES.

(c) 3rd Attack. 2 x LASER TARGET MARKER and 2 x DELAY bombs on Stanley airfield. No explosions seen.

(3) Slippery deck on INVINCIBLE led to Sea Harrier sliding over the side whilst manoeuvring to launch on 30 May. Aircraft lost; pilot recovered.

(4) GLAMORGAN and AMBUSCADE. NGS operations on Stanley airfield on 30/31 May to catch a number of Fucara and helicopters apparently evacuated from Goose Green. Included SEASLUG firing!

(5) 310400G. Ground forces reported ineffective high level bombing east of SAN CARLOS. No damage.

- (6) 310430Q. One VULCAN supported by 15 Victor K2 tankers attacked radar installations at Port Stanley with SHRIKE missiles. First reports indicate that 3 missiles were fired and were believed to be successful. A detailed report is awaited.
- (7) 311130Q. 2 SHAR and 2 GR3 from HMS HERMES attacked possible S-ETENDARD on STANLEY airfield. SHAR suppressed ground fire with 4 x 1000 lbs bombs and 2 GR3 attacked low level with rockets. No S-ETENDARD seen but 4 x PUCARA possibly destroyed. Two GR3 slightly damaged but all returned safely.
- (8) 311130Q. BAHIA PARAISO stopped 5 miles S of BARREN ISLAND. (Extreme SW entrance to FALKLAND SOUND) by a LYNX helo after she had approached without warning. A boarding party in a WESSEX from SAN CARLOS searched but found nothing in contravention of GENEVA Convention (but it is still thought she does have a special communications fit). Earlier on 31 May a message had been sent to the ARGENTINIANS via BRAZIL requesting the BAHIA PARAISO to RV with SS UGANDA some 30 NM N of FALKLAND SOUND for the transfer of 140 wounded ARGENTINIANS. It is assumed this message had not reached her at the time of interception. BAHIA PARAISO was to leave the BAY of HARBOURS at 0900Q this morning calling at PORT STANLEY at 1600Q this pm for wounded and then continue to join UGANDA in the RED CROSS BOX.

b. Deployment in the SAN CARLOS Area - Land Forces.

(1) 40 CDO remains in the general area of SAN CARLOS SETTLEMENT/NE SUSSEX MENS/AJAX BAY.

(2) BMA. The Field Dressing Station (manned by mixed RM and Army Medics) despite receiving several bombs has so far dealt with 246 casualties and performed 79 major operations.

(3) Advance parties HQ CLFTI and HQ 5 BDE arrived yesterday.

c. Forward Deployment.

(1) 2 PARA/COY 42 CDO. DARWIN/GOOSE GREEN. No contacts. Processing of PW continues together with burial arrangements for Enemy dead, now reported to number 200.

(2) 45 CDO. DOUGLAS SETTLEMENT and TEAL INLET. No contacts. RMP establishing POW cage in TEAL in due course.

(3) 3 PARA. Moved from TEAL INLET to MALO BRIDGE. Will move forward to secure fire base for 79 CDO LT BTY. 3 Enemy surrendered yesterday afternoon.

(4) 42 CDO. TAC HQ, and one COY 42 CDO plus 3 Guns CDO LT BTY RA were inserted night 30/31 May by helicopter into area of MOUNT KENT where they made contact with D SQN SAS already in area. There was some enemy activity. One enemy was killed and one stretcher case. En cas thought to be 4 killed. Prior NGS on MT KENT was provided by ALACRITY. It was

proposed to insert the second Company 42 CDO and the remainder 7 CDO LT BTY last night. (3rd Coy 42 CDO is with 2 PARA, 4th Coy in S GEORGIA).

d. Surface Forces Outside TEZ.

(1) S GEORGIA. LYCAON, SAXONIA and RESOURCE sailed to East to lie up in ice to counter possible air threat.

(2) STROMNESS. En route TEZ from S GEORGIA ETA 1300 today.

(3) ANTRIM. En route to S GEORGIA.

(4) QE2. Continues en route to UK.

(5) CONTENDER BEZANT, ST EDMUND and TORCALEDONIA ETD ASI today or tomorrow.

e. Surface Forces in the TEZ.

(1) AMBUSCADE returned to BATTLE Group with SIR GALAHAD.

(2) BRILLIANT escorting ELK and TIDEPOOL to AOA night 31 May/1 Jun.

(3) AVENGER NGS on VOLUNTEER BAY yesterday and then moved to AOA.

f. Ships in the AOA 010500Z JUN. FEARLESS, INTREPID, YARMOUTH, ARROW, MINERVA, AVENGER, SIR LANCELOT, SIR PERCIVALE, ELK, TIDEPOOL and TIDESPRING.

g. RAF.

(1) ASI KIMROD. Local area update mission yesterday.
