- 1. MOD ARE CONTENT WITH THE PRESS LINE PROPOSED BY STATE DEPARTMENT (PARAGRAPH 3 OF TUR).
- 2. WE ARE NOW FACING A FURTHER PUBLIC PRESENTATION DILEMMA,
 THIS TIME ON THE POINT DEFENCE SYSTEM FOR SHIPS, VULCAN PHALANX.
 TWO OF THESE ARE CURRENTLY BEING FITTED TO ILLUSTRIOUS AT THE SWAN
 HUNTER SHIPYARD. THERE IS CONSIDERABLE PARLIAMENTARY INTEREST
 IN WHETHER POINT DEFENCE SYSTEMS ARE TO BE FITTED TO NEW RN
 SHIPS AND, IF SO, WHAT THOSE SYSTEMS WILL BE. NOW THAT
 ILLUSTRIOUS IS BEING FITTED WITH VULCAN PHALANX MOD CAN NO LONGER
 REFUSE TO ANSWER DIRECT QUESTIONS.
