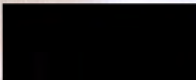

THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITY WAS INTERCEPTED ON AN ARGENTINE MILITARY NET ON THE FALKLAND ISLANDS ON 1 JUNE 1982. SMALL EDITORIAL AMENDMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE TO THE ORIGINAL REPORT WHICH WAS PROVIDED BY A FIELD STATION.

THE ENEMY ACTION IN DARWIN WAS:

1. PRECEDED BY INTENSE NAVAL AND MORTAR FIRE FROM 200100, AGAINST ACYCPC ((AS IN TEXT)).
2. AAC ((COMMENT - POSSIBLY ANTI AIRCRAFT CANNON)) STARTING 0445.

3. RAPID ADVANCE IN THE FACE OF ALL SUPPORTING FIRE AND DETERRENT, AND EVEN DEPLOYED WHILST RECEIVING ((POSSIBLY RECOILLESS)) RIFLES FIRE, AUTOMATIC FIRE AND UNDER AIR ATTACK.
4. ESTIMATED NO OF PERSONNEL WHO WERE EMPLOYED: 1 BENELON (BN) IN THE ATTACK AND 1 BELON (BN) IN RESERVE, WHO THEY RELIEVED OVER THE GROUND OR RELIEVED IN PATROL EMPLOYMENT. IT WAS REINFORCED BY A THIRD FOR THE FINAL ENCIRCLEMENT OF GOOSE GREEN.
5. THEY ATTACKED THROUGH THE WEAKEST POSITION.
6. APPROACH AND ALIGNMENT OF ATTACK MADE BY HELICOPTER.
7. FOR AT LEAST 2 NIGHTS BEFORE THE ATTACK, THEY OCCUPIED THE HEIGHTS SUCH AS REVNIONI AREA, EMLACING WEAPONS AND OBSERVATION POSITIONS.
8. AT LEAST 1 MEMBER OF THE POPULATION COLLABORATED ACTIVELY WITH THE ENEMY GUIDING THEIR ATTACK BY RADIO.
9. ALTHOUGH THE CAPACITY FOR AN IMMINENT ATTACK ON PORT STANLEY STILL EXISTS, WE MUST NOT DISCOUNT GROUND ACTION, SELITRA.S POR CADA S. ANFI. IAS ((AS IN TEXT - POSSIBLY AMPHIBIOUS ATTACKS)) ON YAPEYU .BALL. ((AS IS TEXT)) AS EITHER A DISTRACTION OR CONQUEST.
