SUMMARY

1. YAMANI FORECASTS FAILURE AT THE FORTHCOMING OPEC MEETING, LEADING TO AN ABANDONMENT OF QUOTAS AND THE EFFECTIVE BREAK-UP OF OPEC FOR THE TIME BEING. HE EXPECTS A GRADUAL, BUT POSSIELY DRAMATIC, INCREASE IN PRODUCTION BY SEVERAL PRODUCERS, INCLUDING SAUDI ARABIA, LEADING TO A SHARP DROP IN GIL PRICES.

DETAIL

- 2. IL CALLED ON THE SAUDI OIL MINISTER IN TAIF ON 17 JULY. SHAIKH YAMANI WAS STILL RECOVERING FROM THE VIEWS WHICH PREVENTED HIM FROM PARTICIPATING IN THE VIENNA OPEC MEETING EARLIER THIS MONTH, AND HAD SOME DIFFICULTY WITH HIS VOICE. HE NEVERTHELESS SPOKE FOR ABOUT HALF AN HOUR.
- 3. YAMANI SAID THAT HE WOULD BE LEAVING FOR THE EXECUTIVE COMBITTEE MEETING IN GENEVA ON 20 JULY, BUT THAT HE SAW NO PROSPECT OF ANY SATISFACTORY OUTCOME TO THE OPEC MEETING ITSELF. THE INVITABLE RESULT WOULD BE ARANDONMENT OF OPEC OUDTAS

PROSPECT OF ANY SATISFACTORY OUTCOME TO THE OPEC MEETING ATSELF.

THE ILNEVITABLE RESULT WOULD BE ABANDONMENT OF OPEC QUOTAS,

LEADING SOONER OR LATER TO A SHIGHTHICANT FALL IN PRICES.

SAUDI ARABINA HAD THE CAPACILTY TO INCREASE HER OUTPUT TO 9 MBD,

OR EVEN MORE, WHICH SOULD LEAD TO A DROP IN OHL PRICES AS

LINTLE AS DOLLARS 10. HE DAD NOT EXPECT THIS TO HAPPEN

IMMEDIATELY, BUT A GRADUAL MOVE IN THAT DIRECTION WAS, IN HIS

VIEW, UNAVOIDABLE.

- A. # ASKED HAM WHETHER ANY OF THE PROPOSALS WHICH THE PRESS HAD REPORTED FROM THE VHENNA MEETING (YOUR TELNO 306 WERE LINKELY TO SUCCEED. HE DOUBTED WHETHER ANY OF THEM WOULD BE EFFECTIVE. THE HRACHS HAD PUT FORWARD THEM DEMANDS FOR AN INCREASE IN THEM OWN QUOTA, BUT NO MEMBER OF OPEC WAS PREPARED TO GIVE UP EVEN ONE BARREL OF ONL TO HELP HRAQ. THE HRACHS WERE CLEARLY DETERMINED TO HINCREASE PRODUCTION ANYWAY, AND THEM PIPELINES THROUGH TURKEY AND SAUDI ARABIA WOULD LEAD TO QUITE A STIGNIFICANT INCREASE. IN ASKED ABOUT THE PROSPECTS FOR THE YANBU PIPELINE. YAMANI REPLIED THAT HIT SHOULD BE READY BY THE END OF THE YEAR, WHITH AN HINITHAL THROUGHPUT OF ABOUT 200,000 BD, RISING TO 500,000 BD NEXT YEAR. BOTH THE SAUDIS AND KUWAITHS WOULD OF COURSE STOP EXPORTING OIL ON HRAQ'S BEHALF (HE 180,000 BD FROM SAUDI ARABIA AND 123,000 FROM KUWAIT). BUT THE HRACHS WOULD STALL BE WELL OVER THEM OUOTA.
- F. YAMANI ADDED THAT, HISTORICALLY, OPEC HAD ALLOWED HAN AND HAND A JOINT QUOTA BETWEEN THEM. ALTHOUGH HANNIAN EXPORTS WERE STILL AFFECTED BY CUTBACKS IN THE SHUTTLE SERVICE TO SHRII, THE HANIANS WERE NO LONGER BEHAVING AS RESONSIBLY AS THEY HAD, AND WERE ALSO NOW PRODUCING OVER THEIR QUOTA. ON POLITICAL GROUNDS, THEY WERE ALSO STRENUOUSLY OPPOSING AN INCREASE IN HRAQ'S QUOTA.

 - 6. YAMANI SAID THAT THE ALGERIANS HAD REVIVED AN OLD PROPOSAL AT VIENNA THAT AN OPEC MIX OF 2 .59 3 MBD SHOULD BE SOLD ON THE SPOT MARKET AT A DOLLAR BELOW NORTH SEA PRICES. THE ALGERIAN MINISTER OF OIL HAD EVEN TOLD ONE OPEC COLLEAGUE AT VIENNA THAT ALGERIA WAS DETERMINED TO GO FOR A PRICE WAR, WHICH HE FOUND ASTONISHEG.
 - 7. IT ASKED WHETHER THERE WAS ANY PROPOSAL TO CHANGE THE SUADI MIX BETWEEN HEAVY AND LIGHT CRUDE. YAMANI SAID THAT SOME ADJUSTMENT IN THE PRICE OF HEAVY CRUDE MIGHT BE POSSIBLE, BUT OPEC HAD NOW PASSED THE POINT WHEN CHANGES OF THIS SORT WERE ADEQUATE TO DEAL WITH THE PROBLEM. IT ASKED WHETHER HE WAS TALKING ABOUT THE BREAK-UP OF OPEC? YAMANI REPLIED THAT HE WAS, AT LEAST FOR THE TIME BEING. SAUDI ARABIA WOULD CONTINUE TO CO-OPERATE WITH HER OPEC PARTNERS, BUT SHE HAD DECIDED THAT SHE COULD NO LONGER BEAR THE BURDEN ALONE. HT SADDENED HIM THAT OTHER OPEC PRODUCERS WERE NOT PREPARED TO CO-OPERATE. HE ADDED,

COULD NO LONGER BEAR THE BURDEN ALONE. 11T SADDENED HIM THAT OTHER OPEC PRODUCERS WERE NOT PREPARED TO CO-OPERATE. HE ADDED, WITH A SMILE, THAT OE SAME WENT FOR NON-OPEC PRODUCERS.

- AMERICANS HAD BEEN NOTHFHED THAT SAUD! ARABIA WOULD START PRODUCING AT 9 MBD. YAMAN! SAID THAT HT APPARENTLY AROSE FROM SOMETHING WHICH THE UNLITED STATES ENERGY SECRETARY HAD SAID TO THE NEW YORK TIMES AND THE WALL STREET JOURNAL IN PARIS, AND THAT HE HAD HIMSELF "HAD TO PUT OUT A DENIAL THAT WHAT THE SECRETARY HAD SAID HAD ANY BASIS OF TRUTH". HE COULD NEVERTHELESS TELL ME "AS A FRIEND" THAT HE EXPECTED THIS TO HAPPEN. WHEN IT ASKED WHETHER SAUDI ARABIA WOULD STILL KEEP TO INTO QUOTA OF 4.35 MBD, HE REPLIED "THERE WILL BE NO QUOTAS NOW".
- 9. IT ASKED WHETHER OTHER OPEC MEMBERS HAD COMPARABLE CAPACITY TO INCREASE PRODUCTION. HE REPLIED THAT BOTH IRAC AND KUWAIT COULD INCREASE THEIR PRODUCTION LEVELS, AS COULD NIGERIA. VENEZUELA AND ECUADOR WERE ALSO VERY EXPENSIVE PRODUCERS, WHO WOULD BE VERY READY TO INCREASE THEIR PRODUCTION OF POSSIBLE. IN REPLY TO MY QUESTION, HE SAID THAT HE DID NOT THINK THAT THE KUWAITIS WERE CONCERNED ABOUT DEPLETION.
- 10. IT ASKED FOR HIS ASSESSMENT OF THE EFFECTS OF LOW PRICES
 ON THE THIRD WORLD, COMMENTING THAT THE MAJOR OIL-PRODUCING
 DEBTORS WERE LIKELY TO SUFFER PARTICULARLY BADLY. HE AGREED THAT
 THE EFFECT COULD BE DRAMATIC, AS INDEED IT WOULD BE ON THE
 WHOLE INDUSTRIALISED WORLD. IT COULD QUICKLY LEAD TO
 A BANKING CRISIS IN THE UNITED STATES. BUT PRESENT SITUATION
 COULD SIMPLY NOT CONTINUE. I ASKED WHETHER HE EXPECTED A DEMAND
 FOR 9 MBD OR MORE. YAMANI REPLIED THAT STOCKS WERE AT PRESENT
 DANGEROUSLY LOW, AND THAT MANY COMPANIES WOULD BE READY TO BUY AT
 LOWER PRICES FOR THEIR STOCKS. WHEN IT ASKED ABOUT THE EFFECT ON
 SAUDI FINANCIAL RESOURCES, YAMANI ADMITTED THAT THE ADVANTAGES
 OF QUADRUPLING PRODUCTION AT A THIRD THE PRICE WERE LIMITED: BUT
 THERE WOULD NEVERTHELESS BE SOME IMPROVEMENT.
- 11. ! ASKED WHETHER THERE WAS REALLY NO HOPE THAT SOME MECHANISM COULD BE DEVISED TO STOP OTHER OPEC MEMBERS Z'GABABLEG'AGREEDMANIVSBEDATHAT
 THAT THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL SHOULD KEEP AN EYE ON FRINGE DEALS, AND IT HAD BEEN AGREED THAT INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS SHOULD REPORT TO THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL. BUT HE DOUBTED WHETHER THEY WOULD, OR WHETHER THE MECHANISM WOULD BE EFFECTIVE.
- 12. IN CONCLUSION, YAMANI SAID THAT HE HAD NO DOUBT THAT
 THE FIRST REACTION OF SOME PEOPLE TO OPEC'S COLLAPSE WOULD BE
 PLEASURE, BUT THAT ON REFLECTION MOST PEOPLE WOULD
 BE SAD AT THE PROSPECT. I SAID THAT IT WAS SURE THERE
 WOULD BE NO REJOICING IN THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT, PARTICULARLY
 IF THE COLLAPSE OF OPEC LED TO A DRAMATIC FALL IN PRICES ON
 THE LINES HE HAD SUGGESTED. YAMANI REPEATED THAT THIS NEED
 NOT NECESSARILY HAPPEN OUICKLY, BUT HE WAS SURE THAT IT
 WOULD HAPPEN NEVERTHELESS. WHEN I COMMENTED THAT THIS MUST

BE ONE OF THE MOST DIFFICULT POINTS IN HIS LONG CAREER,
YAMANI REPLIED THAT THINGS BECAME MUCH LESS DIFFICULT ONCE
ONE HAD STOPPED FRIGHTING.

13. COMMENT: THERE WAS NO DOUBT AN ELEMENT OF FLESH-CREEPING AN WHAT YAMANA HAD TO SAY, ALTHOUGH (WAITH THE ONE EXCEPTION OF HAS REFERENCE TO NON-OPEC MEMBERS IN PARA 7 ABOVE) HE NOTICEABLY REFRAINED FROM ANY RECRIMINATION OVER HMG'S POLICIES OR PRODUCTION LEVELS. THE EXTRAORDIANRY CONFLICTS AND CONTRADICTIONS IN SAUDI PRESS TREATMENT OVER THE PAST WEEK OR SO (MY TUR) NO DOUBT REFLECT AN INTERNAL DEBATE HERE. BUT YAMANI CERTAINLY LEFT ME WITH THE IMPRESSION THAT HE IS RESIGNED TO AT LEAST THE TEMPORARY BREAK-UP OF OPEC AS AN EFFECTIVE BODY.
