1. REPORTS OF MR KINGS REMARKS IN BRUSSELS AND SUBSEQUENT EFFORTS BY THE PRIME MINISTER AND TAGISEACH AT DAMAGE LIMITATION OCCUPY THE MASTHEAD POSITION IN ALL DUBLIN NEWSPAPERS.

''KING'S BRUSSELS GAFFE'' IS THE IRISH PRESS HEADLINE: THE IRISH TIMES, ''KING SAYS DUBLIN ACCEPTS PARTITION IN PERPETUITY'': AND THE IRISH INDEPENDENT ''THATCHER RUSH TO REPAIR KING'S 'NO UNITY' GAFFE''. ALL NEWSPAPERS FOCUS ON THE EFFORTS BY THE PRIME MINISTER AND TACKSEACH TO LIMIT DAMAGE TO THE ANGLO-IRISH AGREEMENT. THE PRIME MINISTER'S INTERVIEW ON THE MATTER WAS CARRIED ON RTE RADIO THIS MORNING. IT WAS NOTED THAT THIS IS THE FIRST INTERVIEW SHE HAS EVER GIVEN TO HRISH RADIO.

  DR FITZGERALD IS SAID TO BE BAFFLED AND ANGRY, AND HIS STATEMENT THAT MR KING HAD MADE REMARKS 'WHICH WERE SINGULARLY INAPPROPRIATE AND INACCURATE' IS WIDELY REPORTED.
- FITZGERALD IN THE SOUP. 'IT CERTAINLY PUTS THE SDLP IN A DIFFICULT POSITION PARTICULARLY MR SEAMUS MALLON WHO HAS BEEN GIVEN FOOD FOR THOUGHT BY MR KING'. 4. THE IRISH TIMES LEADER 'NEVER SAY NEVER' DESCRIBES MR KING AS MAKING A GAFFE OF A VERY AWKWARD AND EMBARRASSING KIND. "THE GOV GOVERNMENT 'S OPPONENTS ON THE NATIONALIST SIDE NORTH AND SOUTH WILL SEIZE ON MR KINGS STATEMENT AS PROOF OF A SELL-OUT' AND "NOR IS IT LIKELY TO DO MUCH TOWARDS ACHIEVING THAT CURRENT PRIORITY REASSU-URING THE UNIONISTS. THE WAY TO REASSURE THEM IS NOT TO CLAIM THE ABANDONMENT OF NATIONALIST ASPIRATIONS, BUT IN THE SHORT TERM TO BRING ABOUT A DIMINUTION IN VIOLENCE AND IN THE LONGER TERM TO SHOW THEM THAT, IN THE NEW ARRANGEMENTS UNDER THE HILLSBOROUGH AGREEMENT AND UNDER ANY FUTURE CONSTITUTIONAL ARRANGE-MENTS THEIR RIGHTS AND LIBERTIES WILL BE GUARANTEED ". THE IRISH INDEPENDENT REFERS TO MR KING'S "UNFORTUNATE DEPARTURE FROM A PREPARED SCRIPT TO OPINE THAT FOR ALL PRACTICAL PURPOSES AND IN PERPETUTBY THE RECENT AGREEMENT MEANS THAT THERE WILL NEVER BE A UNITED IRELAND, CRASH LANDED ON A STATEMENT FROM MRS THATCHER AND DR FITZGERALD THAT THE HILLSBOROUGH AGREEMENT WOULD BE IMPLEME-NTED AS PLANNED. THE TIMING OF THIS COMMENT WAS BAD'', AND 'BOTH DR FHTZGERALD AND MRS THATCHER ARE DOING WHAT THEY CAN TO PROVE THAT THEY DO INTEND TO IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENT ..
