Prime Minister, The Rt. Hon Margaret Thatcher M.P.

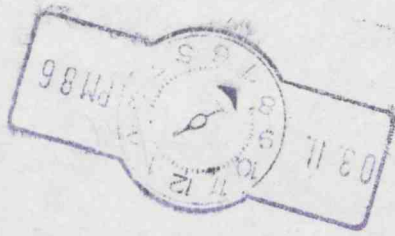
The Government and I have been horrified to learn of the attempted  
mass murder of members of the UDR at Belcoo which has led to  
the death of one member and injuries to seven others.

All possible co-operation will be extended by our strengthened  
security forces in the border areas to assist in tracking down  
and bringing to justice those responsible who may be found in  
our jurisdiction.

Our deepest sympathy goes to the family of the victim and to those  
injured.
