- 1. STATE BRHEFED US ON 29 MAY ABOUT THE LATEST PHASE HIN THE TABA NEGOTHATHONS. SOFAER'S EFFORTS APPEAR TO HAVE COME TO NOTHING.
- 2. ACCORDING TO STATE SOFAER SPENT TEN HOURS IN JERUSELAM ON 28 MAY CONSTRUCTING YET ANOTHER APPROACH TO THE QUESTION FOR THE ARBITRATORS. TO MOVE AWAY FROM THE QUOTE CORRECT/EXACT UNQUOTE DEADLOCK, HE WAS TRYING A PACKAGE, WHICH INVOLVED ADDING A PREAMBLE AND AN ANNEX TO THE BASIC QUESTION. THE INSRAELING AGREED TO DROP THE WORD QUOTE CORRECT UNQUOTE, BUT REFUSED TO ACCEPT AN EGYPTIAN DRAFT QUOTE SAFETY-NET CLAUSE UNQUOTE IN THE PACKAGE. (QUOTE THE TRIBUNAL SHALL STILL STRUCTLY OBSERVE THE STATUS QUO ANTE BELLUM WHICH EXISTED PRIOR TO THE ISRAELING OCCUPATION OF SHINAW IN 1967 UNQUOTE.)
- 3. SOFAER RETURNED TO CAMPO ON 29 MAY WITH MISRAEL'S MODAFMICATIONS TO THE PACKAGE WHICH HE HAD SOME HOPES THE EGYPTMANS WOULD ACCEPT. BUT MEGUND SAND ONLY THAT HE WOULD REFER THE TEXT TO A CONSULTATIONE COMMITTEE FOR STUDY AND ADDED THAT THE UNMITED STATES MUST UNDERSTAND THAT THE CONCEPT IN THE SAFETY NET CLAUSE WAS THE KEY TO EGYPT'S POSITION AND WOULD NOT BE DROPPED: THE ARBITRATORS HAD TO ADDRESS THAT CONCEPT DIRECTLY. SOFAER DECIDED THAT THES DID NOT GIVE HIM ENOUGH NEGOTIMATING ROOM FOR A FURTHER SHUTTLE AND SET COURSE FOR HOME.
- 4. AS OF 29 MAY, STATE DAD NOT KNOW AN WHAT TERMS SOFAER WOULD DESCRIBE THE EGYPTHAN POSITION TO THE ASSABLAGE. THEY ASKED US, THEREFORE, TO HANDLE THIS ANFORMATION DISCREETLY. AT WAS LAKELY SOFAER WOULD LEAVE THE WAY OPEN FOR FURTHER CONTACTS. THE EGYPTHAN POSITION MIGHT CONCERVABLY UNBEND AFTER A PERIOD OF REFLECTION. BUT FOR THE MOMENT THE AMERICANS COULD SEE NO WAY FORWARD.
