YOUR TELNO 614: FALKLAND ISLANDS

- 1. I HAVE SEEN HAIG. I REFERRED TO THE PRIME MINISTER'S MESSAGE
 TO THE PRESIDENT WHICH HE SAID HE HAD SEEN. HE TOLD ME THAT HE
 UNDERSTOOD THAT YOU HAD BEEN DISSATISFIED WITH THE AMERICAN ATTITUDE
 AS CONVEYED BY STOESSEL TO ME ON 29 MARCH. I SAID THAT THIS WAS
 CERTAINLY SO. THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT UNDERSTOOD THE AMERICAN
 WISH NOT TO TAKE SIDES IN A POLITICAL DISPUTE ABOUT THE FUTURE OF
 THE FALKLAND ISLANDS: BUT WHAT WE WERE INVOLVED WITH NOW WAS
 SOMETHING COMPLETELY DIFFERENT, A POTENTIALLY FORCEFUL THREAT TO
 BRITISH SOVEREIGNTY. THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT HAD HELPED AMERICA IN
 DIFFICULT TIMES EVEN THOUGH IT WAS HARD FOR US TO DO SO AND WE
 THOUGHT WE WERE NOT BEING UNREASONABLE IN ASKING THE US FOR
 BACKING WHEN A THREAT TO TERRITORY OCCURRED, PARTICULARLY IN THE
 AMERICAN HEMISPHERE.
- 2. HAIG INTERJECTED IMMEDIATELY THAT THE BRITISH HAD INDEED STOOD BY THE AMERICANS. HE WOULD NEVER FORGET WHAT YOU HAD DONE. THEY HAD EVERY RIGHT TO EXPECT SOMETHING IN RETURN.
- THEAT TO THE FALKLAND ISLANDS OUTLINING SOME OF THE INTELLIGENCE UPON WHICH OUR FEARS ABOUT ARGENTINIAN INTENTIONS WERE BASED. IN PARTICULAR I MENTIONED THE ARGENTINE ASSAULT FORCE COMPRISING SEVERAL UNITS INCLUDING A LANDING FORCE, THAT WE KNEW WAS INTENDED TO REACH ITS DESTINATION BY EARLY ON THE MORNING OF 2 APRIL, THIS WOULD BE COMPATIBLE WITH ARRIVAL AT PORT STANLEY. A SUBMARINE WITH ORDERS TO CARRY OUT BEACH RECONNAISANCE FOR AN AMPHIBIOUS LANDING WAS ALSO IN THE AREA AS WAS A NAVAL TRANSPORT VESSEL. I MENTIONED FURTHER INDICATIONS OF ARGENTINE PREPARATIONS FOR MILITARY ACTION INCLUDING INCREASED INTELLIGENCE GATHERING AND PREPARATIONS FOR THE DEPLOYMENT OF THE LARGENTINE SUBMARINE FLEET. I ALSO REFERRED THE ARGENTINE AIR FORCE FLIGHTS OVER THE FALKLAND ISLANDS YESTERDAY.
- 4. THIS WAS BACKED UP BY EXTREMELY DELICATE INTELLIGENCE SUGGESTING THAT THE ARGENTINE MILITARY JUNTA WERE CONTEMPLATING ACTION.
- THE FACT THAT THE ARGENTINE FOREIGN MINISTER HAD BEEN OVERRULED BY THE JUNTA WHEN HE WAS PURSUING A DIPLOMATIC SOLUTION
 ALSO POINTED IN A DANGEROUS DIRECTION. HAIG JUMPED IN TO SAY
 THAT THIS WAS ALL HORRIFYING AND TOTALLY NEW TO HIM. NO WONDER
 WE WERE CONCERNED BY THE AMERICAN RESPONSE. ALL HE HAD KNOWN
 WAS THE STORY ABOUT THE LAND OF A SMALL NUMBER OF ARGENTINIANS
 IN SOUTH GEORGIA. BUT WHAT I HAD JUST TOLD HIM WAS A COMPLETELY
 DIFFERENT MATTER AND REQUIRED THE MOST URGENT ACTION. HE REPEATED
 SEVERAL TIMES THAT HE HAD BEEN GIVEN NO INTELLIGENCE OF THIS KIND.
 THE MEMBERS OF HIS STAFF WHO WERE PRESENT, SOME OF
 WHOM I KNOW WERE AWARE OF THE SAME MATERIAL, REMAINED SILENT.
- 6. ENDERS, WHO WAS WITH US, SAID THAT THEY HAD RECEIVED AN ASSURANCE FROM THE ARGENTINE FOREIGN MINISTER THAT THE ARGENTINIANS WERE NOT CONTEMPLATING CONFRONTATION: INDEED THEY HAD HAD THIS ASSURANCE CONFIRMED.
- 7. I SAID THAT OUR REPORTS OF THE LINE BEING TAKEN
 BY THE ARGENTINE FOREIGN MINISTER WERE VERY DIFFERENT. HE WAS
 FINDING ALL SORTS OF REASONS WHY THE FAR-REACHING OFFERS WE
 HAD MADE FOR DIPLOMATIC SOLUTIONS OF THE PROBLEM WERE NOT

- 7. I SAID THAT OUR REPORTS OF THE LINE BEING TAKEN
 BY THE ARGENTINE FOREIGN MINISTER WERE VERY DIFFERENT. HE WAS
 FINDING ALL SORTS OF REASONS WHY THE FAR-REACHING OFFERS WE
 HAD MADE FOR DIPLOMATIC SOLUTIONS OF THE PROBLEM WERE NOT
 FEASIBLE. WE HAD GONE SO FAR AS TO TELL HIM OF OUR READINESS
 TO SEND A SPECIAL ENVOY TO WORK OUT A SETTLEMENT. IT LOOKED,
 THOUGH, AS IF THE FOREIGN MINISTER WAS NOT IN CONTROL.
- 8. THE ONLY PERSON WHO, I TOLD HAIG, COULD AT THIS HOUR AVERT A VERY DANGEROUS COURSE BY THE ARGENTINE MILITARY AUTHORITIES WOULD BE THE ARGENTINE PRESIDENT HIMSELF. FOR THAT TO HAPPEN IT WOULD BE ESSENTIAL FOR THE PRESIDENT TO SEND A VERY FIRM MESSAGE VERY SOON. I UNDERLINED TO HAIG HOW EARLY THE ARGENTINIANS MIGHT BE INTENDING TO ACT.
- 9. HAIG SAID THAT HE MUST GET INTO ACTION IMMEDIATELY ON THIS SUBJECT. THERE WAS NO QUESTION ABOUT THE NEED TO SUPPORT THE BRITISH ON THIS MATTER OF STOPPING THE USE OF ARGENTINIAN FORCE. HE REPEATED AGAIN HIS UNAWARENESS OF WHAT HAD BEEN HAPPENING. HE WOULD DO EVERYTHING HE COULD TO ENSURE THAT A MESSAGE WENT OFF TO THE ARGENTINE PRESIDENT FORTHWITH.
- 10. IT IS WORTH BEARING IN MIND HOW INTENSELY THE STATE
 DEPARTMENT HAVE BEEN FOCUSSING ON EL SALVADOR. I WAS TOLD HOW
 HELPFUL THE ARGENTINIANS HAD BEEN OVER EL SALVADOR WHICH
 MAY PARTLY EXPLAIN THE RELUCTANCE OF THE AMERICANS TO TAKE
 OFF THE GLOVES WITH THEM OVER THE FALKLANDS. BUT I AM SURE HAIG
 WILL DO SO NOW
