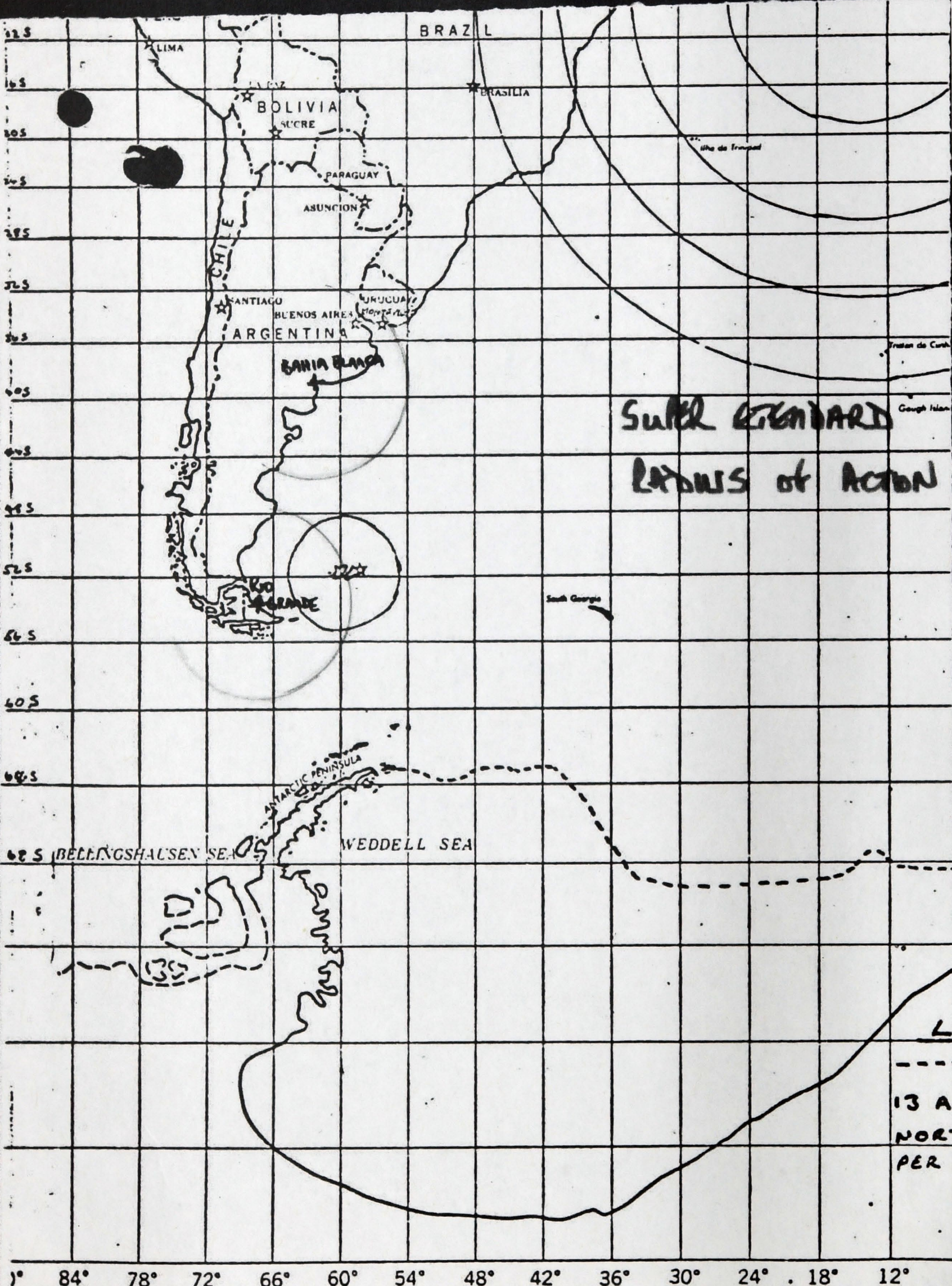

1. Base Bahia Blanca, but a not altogether reliable Chilean source says they are at RIO GRANDE. (Mr DA said R. Grande)
2. Radius Action 375nm with one EXOCET.
3. Avionics. ECM - NIL. ESM - RWR. Has inertial nav but cannot align this to the carrier inertial platform. Radio/Radar altimeter. No data link.
4. Air to Air Refuelling. Believed only to be possible from the two KC-130 tankers. May at a long shot from A4's. Cannot buddy.
5. Experience. Operation from carrier not practised, not AAR. Flying in poor weather not thought to be good.
