FOLLOW-ON FORCES MEETING 4 MAY 82 RECORD OF PLANNING DECISIONS AND OUTSTANDING ACTION

ADJUSTMENTS TO 5 INF BDE (SLIMLINE)

- 1. Some adjustments were made and a revised staff table is shown at Annex A. The main adjustments are to:
 - a. 407 Tpt Tp (Serial 9) increased by 12 men.
 - b. 81 Ord Coy (Serial 11) increased by 28 specialists.
 - c. 10 Fd Wksp (Serial 12) increased by 4 x 4 ton repair vehicles.

PLANNING DECISIONS

- 2. There are four categories of follow up as shown below:
 - a. First Follow Up. The balance of Combat Arms and 2nd line logistic units of 5 Inf Bde. Some elements of the 3rd line support have been added and a desalination plant may be included. The initial bids from 5 Inf Bde, which will be subject to refinement, are shown at Annex B. Deployment timings depend on shipping availability which is now very limited. Ideally 14 days after dispatch of the main body but may well be later.
 - b. Airfield Construction. Engineer Airfield Construction assets including: 50 Fd Sqn (Const) and other units, plant and material. Details were in the draft paper on Provision of Airfield Facilities (DGO/80/2). Engineers actually deployed for this may be reduced to take account of those already deployed in the two brigades. This would be treated as a separate issue although it may use some of the First Follow Up shipping.
 - c. Second 30 Days WMR. Four battalions worth of 30 days WMR is already afloat to support the entire force of 8 battalions. A further 4 battalions worth was to be earmarked and held in depots until the requirement is clarified by 2 Star HQ.
 - d. Long Term. Further units of 3rd line support were earmarked for consideration at a later stage. These include:

- (1) HQ LSG and Sig Det.
- (2) 9 Ord Bn(-).
- (3) 2 Fd Hosp.
- (4) 8 San RCT.
- (5) 59 MC Son (Airfld Ops).
- (6) 518 Coy RPC.

FURTHER STAFF ACTION

3. Two Star HQ.

- a. To review the required arrival times of the follow on forces particularly the First Follow Up and the engineers.
- b. To review the arrangements for provision of rations, fuel and water when task brigades are deployed.
- c. To control 3rd line logistic assets as Force Troops.
- 4. ASD 2. To issue and revise staff tables.

5. DAP(A)/ALOC.

- a. To investigate the provision of a second 30 days WMR for 4 battalions and indicate any Priority 1 penalties incurred.
- ${\tt b.}$ $\,$ To investigate the provision of Gurkha rations in the long term.
- c. To review the logistic plan in general in conjunction with the DCOS G1/G4 of the 2 Star HQ.

6. <u>Engr 1</u>.

- a. To produce and revise the staff table for the airfield construction force including the provision of matting from US $\mbox{\sc Army}$ resources.
- b. To advise on other requirements for engineers such as STREs, port reconstruction, hutting and water supply.
- 7. COS Endorsement. Provision of further rft will be subject to cos agreement.
