ATTENDANCE

- 2. CNS has been asked to attend by SofS' office with the aim of updating OD(SA) on SHEFFIELD, in continuation of the discussions held at OD(SA) in the evening of 4 May.
- 3. CAS has been informed of this and was content.
- 4. CNS may be invited to leave on completion of this business but in case of need I have gathered together the papers which I understand are then likely to be considered.

IDEAS FOR A NEW DIPLOMATIC MOVE

- 5. The paper under discussion is a draft message from Mr Pym to Mr Haig (FLAG D) covered by an explanatory note (FLAG C).
- 6. Direct military considerations are only briefly involved in the arrangements for initiating the ceasefire ($\frac{TAB}{T} = \frac{TAG}{T} = \frac{D}{T}$). SSN ROE might be hard to alter "immediately". (See para 3 of $\frac{TLAG}{T} = \frac{D}{T}$).

- 7. The only other points which occur to me are:
 - a. South Georgia is not mentioned which as we hold it is probably satisfactory.
 - b. There is no reference to the South Sandwich Islands but perhaps this is not a military point.

LINE TO TAKE

- 8. CNS should be ready to give the latest details on SHEFFIELD and any other relevant Naval matters.
- 9. CNS needs to read FLAGs C and D and para 3 of FLAG E in case he is invited to remain for what will be primarily a political discussion on the Peruvian proposals.
