- B. HMS HERMES 19F/JUA 032330Z MAY 82 (NOTAL)(PROPOSE COORD RESPONSE)

 - 1. FOUR AIR TO AIR ENGAGEMENTS AGAINST ARG MIRAGE 5 AND CANBERRA AIRCRAFT UNDERTAKEN BY THIS UNIT 1 MAY 82. TWO ENGAGEMENTS WERE SUCCESSFUL.
 - 2. SEA HARRIER V MIRAGE
 - A. ARG FTRS ON CAP TO WEST OF FALKLANDS. THEY OPERATED AS PAIRS AND

PROBED TOWARDS SHAR CAP POSITIONS ATTEMPTING TO SEDUCE SHAR TO LONG RANGE FROM TASK GROUP. WHEN COMMITTED TO INTERCEPT UNDER PRECISE CONTROL OF FALKLAND BASED GCI RADAR (PROB AN/TPS 43) THEY APPROACH INTERCEPT POINT AT SUPERSONIC SPEED HIGH LEVEL (FL300 TO FL380). BEFORE INTERCEPTION IT APPEARS THEY DIVE TOWARDS GCI PREDICTED POINT OF INTERCEPT AND RELEASE THEIR WEAPONS HEAD ON. OF THE SEVEN MISSILES FIRED AT 801 NAS, SIX WERE RELEASED FROM A LOOK DOWN POSITION. POST FLIGHT ANALYSIS OF MISSILES AND MIRAGE DURING FLY THROUGH SUGGESTS THAT SEVERAL MISSILES WERE RELEASED WITHOUT MIRAGE PILOTS POSITIVELY ACQUIRING SHAR. ALSO BELIEVED ARG PILOTS RELEASING SIDEWINDER 9B OR MATRA MAGIC R550 MISSILES FROM HEAD-ON POSITIONS WITH NO CHANCE OF SUCCESS. AFTER FIRING, MIRAGES EXIT FIGHT IN STRAIGHT LINE AT HIGH SPEED.

- B. ENGAGEMENT 1. 2 SHAR VECTORED FOR TARGETS AT 45 MILES. FL150 CONTACT GAINED AT 8 MILES TARGET HIGH. TARGETS DIVED ON SHAR 1 MISSILE BEING RELEASED AT 4 MILES HEAD ON. MISSED BY 200 YDS. SECOND TARGET DESCENDED TO FL120, PULLED UP AND FIRED AT 2 MILES AS SHAR TURNED TOWARDS. MISSILE MISSED BY 30 YDS TARGETS FLEW THROUGH AND DEPARTED AT MAX SPEED
- C. ENGAGEMENT 2. 2 X SHAR CAP AT FL200 VECTORED FOR TARGETS AT APPROX

FL50. APPROACHED HEAD ON. SHAR DESCENDED TO FL150 IN ATTEMPT TO LURE TARGETS LOWER. 3 MISSILES FIRED FROM HIGH LEVEL AT SHAR AND SEEN TO FALL WELL SHORT INFRONT SHAR. TARGETS NOT SEEN BY SHAR
D. ENGAGEMENT 3. 2 SHAR CAP VECTORED FOR HEAD ON ATTACK SHAR GAINED CONTACT AT 17 MILES FL150 SAME LEVEL. ARGS IN 1 MILE TRAIL 30 DEGREES DISPLACED. LEAD SHAR ATTEMPTED HEAD ON SHOT BUT NO ACQUISITION. ARG LDR FIRED HEAD ON. MISSED BY 300 YARDS. SHAR NO2 HOOKED IN BEHIND ARG NO2 FIRED GUNS FROM 1000 YDS - MISSED - AS ARGS ACCELERATED AWAY SHAR NO2 ACQUIRED WITH AIM 9L AND SPLASHED ARG NO2. SHAR LDR HAD NOW TURNED IN BEHIND ARG LDR AND FIRED AIM 9L FROM 1000 YDS AT ARG LDR WHO WAS IN STEEP DIVE FOR CLOUD AT 3000 FT. MISSILE PASSED VERY CLOSE TO TAIL AS AIRCRAFT ENTERED CLOUD. NO CLAIM. GOOD SHOT

- A. ALWAYS FIGHT AS A PAIR EXCEPT IN IMC
- B. APPROACH HEAD ON IN WIDE BATTLE AT MAX SPEED
- C. BETWEEN 15 TO 10 MILES ONE AIRCRAFT RELEASES CHAFF HOTEL FROM AIRBRAKE (LOCAL MODIFICATION EMBODIES AFTER ADVICE DAEO 899) BOTH AIRCRAFT TURN OUTWARDS 30 DEGREES AND UNLOAD NOSE BELOW HORIZON
- D. TURN BACK INTO THREAT TO ACHIEVE QUARTER ATTACK FROM ONE SIDE AND BEAM ATTACK FROM OTHER SIDE

- 3. WATCH FOR MISSILE RELEASE AGAINST CHAFF H IF NOT IN RADAR CONTACT OR TALLY HO
- F. PULL UP TO RELEASE AIM 9L. CROSS INWARDS TO MENACE SECOND BOGEY

4. SHAR VERSUS CANBERRA AND PUCARA

A. ENGAGEMENT 4. 3 ARG CANBERRA APPROACHED FORCE HIGH LOW PROFILE IN LOOSE LOW LEVEL STRIKE FORMATION. CONTACT LOST AT 110 MILES. SHAR LOCAP OF TWO AIRCRAFT VECTORED TOWARDS AT FL50 USING LOW LEVEL AUTONOMOUS SEARCH TECHNIQUE (2-5000 FEET WITH EDGE OF RADAR BEAM TOUCHING SURFACE). THREE TARGETS DETECTED 21 MILES AT APPROX 50 FEET STERN ATTACK BY FIRST SHAR WITH 2 AIM 9L FROM 250 FEET 1 MILE SPLASHED LEAD AIRCRAFT. SECOND MISSILE FIRED WHEN FIRST APPEARED TO MISS. HOWEVER DIRECT HIT OBSERVED AS SECOND MISSILE FIRED. SECOND CANBERRA JETTISONED ALL STORES AND WEAPONS AND BUSTERED. SECOND SHAR FIRED TWO AIM 9L FROM ASTERN AT 250 FEET 2 MILES RANGE AT THIRD CANBERRA. NO HITS SEEN

B. THREE PUCARA BOUNCED CLOSE INSHORE AT LOW LEVEL UNDER CLOUD. TARGETS IMMEDIATELY EVADED WILDLY. DROPPING ORDNANCE AND ENTERING CLOUD. TWO 30MM PASSES MADE AGAINST FLEETING TARGETS BETWEEN CLOUD COVER. NO CLAIMS

- A. SIX SIDEWINDER AIM 9L FIRED. TWO SPLASHED TARGETS. ONE FIRED AS TARGET DESTROYED. TWO FIRED FROM VERY LOW LEVEL AT EXTREME RANGE. NO HITS OBSERVED. ONE FIRED FROM HIGH ANGLE OFF QUARTER ATTACK. MAY HAVE HIT A/C AS IT ENTERED CLOUD.
- B. SEVEN ENEMY MISSILES FIRED. TWO NEAR MISSES BUT NO SUCCESSES. SOME MISSILES FIRED INTO SUN AND OTHERS OUT OF RANGE
