MY TELNO 427: FRENCH POLICY ON FALKLANDS

1. WHEN I CALLED ON MAUROY THIS MORNING MUCH OF THE CONVERSATION
WAS ON THE SUBJECT OF THE FALKLANDS. MAUROY TOOK THE SAME LINE
AS GUTMANN YESTERDAY (MY TUR) ALTHOUGH IN MORE GENERAL TERMS.
HE EMPHASISED THE DESIRABILITY OF A UK INITIATIVE TO HELP BRING
ABOUT NEGOTIATIONS AND THE POSSIBLE ROLE OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL
OF THE UN. I POINTED OUT THE NEED NOT TO CONDONE OR REWARD THE
ARGENTINE AGRESSION. MAUROY SAID HE FULLY ACCEPTED THIS AND
REITERATED THAT THE FRENCH POSITION, AS LAID DOWN BY THE PRESIDENT,
WAS ONE OF SOLIDARITY WITH THE UK. FRANCE HAD TO TAKE ACCOUNT OF
PUBLIC OPINION WHICH HAD REACTED STRONGLY TO THE ESCALATION OF
FIGHTING BUT THIS DID NOT AFFECT BASIC FRENCH POLICY.
