FALKLANDS: EUROPEAN LIBERALS AND DEMOCRATS CONGRESS IN VENICE

1. THIS CONGRESS TOOK PLACE IN VENICE ON 7-8 MAY, FOLLOWED BY
A PUBLIC MEETING ON Ø9 MAY AT WHICH SPADOLINI AMONG OTHERS
SPOKE. MUCH OF THE PROCEEDINGS WERE DEVOTED TO ECONOMIC QUESTIONS, EUROPEAN UNION AND A GREATER ROLE FOR THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT. A MEMBER OF MY STAFF ATTENDED FOR PART OF THE TIME,
AND A REPORT WILL FOLLOW BY BAG.

2. INEVITABLY THE FALKLANDS AROSE, AND MIFT CONTAINS THE TEXT OF A RESOLUTION THAT THE CONGRESS ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY. THIS WILL GUIDE THE LIBERAL BLOC IN THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT IN A FURTHER DEBATE ON THE FALKLANDS WHICH WE UNDERSTAND WILL TAKE PLACE LATER THIS WEEK. THE TEXT IS A GREAT IMPROVEMENT ON AN FARLIER PVV (BELGIAN) AND VENSTRE (DANISH) DRAFT SUPPORTED BY THE GERMAN FDP. WE WERE IN TOUCH WITH MESSRS STEEL AND JOHNSTON, BUT THEY NEEDED LITTLE PROMPTING TO PRESS FOR AMENDMENTS, ESP-ECIALLY ON THE LINK BETWEEN CEASEFIRE AND WITHDRAWAL, ON CONDE-MNATION OF THE ARGENTINE INVASION AND ON FULL SUPPORT FOR SCR 502 AS A WHOLE. MADAME WEIL INTERVENED USEFULLY TO URGE DELEG-ATES NOT TO BACKTRACK ON THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT'S RESOLUTION OF 22 APRIL (THOUGH PARA 3 OF THE TEXT IN MIFT MODIFIES THE EARLIER RESOLUTION'S DEMAND FOR PRIOR ARGENTINE WITHDRAWAL) FROM THIS POST'S POINT OF VIEW, WE WERE GRATEFUL TO MR JOHNSTON FOR THANK-ING OUR EUROPEAN PARTNERS FOR THEIR SUPPORT AND FOR EXPRESSING PARTICULAR UNDERSTANDING OF ITALY'S POSITION.
