1. OPERATION SUTTON.

a. The meeting agreed that the Operation should take place and CINCFLEET authorised to make all necessary preparations. It was understood that a "hold" could be put on the Operation up to Thursday afternoon but a specific decision would have to be taken to do so. The COS' advice was the basis for these decisions.
