1. No military decisions were taken.

OD(SA) DEBRIEF - 18 MAY 19821. OPERATION SUTTON.

a. The meeting agreed that the Operation should take place and CINCFLEET authorised to make all necessary preparations. It was understood that a "hold" could be put on the Operation up to Thursday afternoon but a specific decision would have to be taken to do so. The COS' advice was the basis for these decisions. In discussion the point was strongly made that a speedy completion was essential for political and diplomatic reasons.

b. MOONSHINE. The meeting approved the MOD proposals for MOONSHINE.
