- Intense diplomatic activity to prevent sailing

3. Argentinian Surface Ships

- No intelligence on Carrier's whereabouts.
- Commodoro Py delayed with defects in Puerto Belgrano
- PIEDRA BUENA and BOUCHARD entered Ushuaia early 19 May. May be ready to leave am today.
- Attack on BUEN SUCESSO caused some damage and possibly 5 casualties.

4. Submarines.

- San Luis at Puerto Belgrano only 1 s/m at soa.
- Salta presumed in TEZ

Army 5.

- Warning issued that PUCARA will patrol to search for and fire on unidentified personnel outside base areas on FI.
- Minor redispositions being undertaken.

6. Air

- Argentinian concern over vulnerability of Rio Grande Air Base.
- Some evidence of resupply flights Rio Grande to FI which may have included 5500 KG (25 drums) of JP1 and 6500 KG of provisions. Chia
- Radar intercept of Neptune on 19 May. No position but quite possible in TEZ area.

a. Surface Forces (North to South)

- (1) QE2. Arrives at RV 50nm West of Ascension at 1000Z today. Additional passengers at Ascension including CLF FI and staff, transfer via Guardship.
- (2) Bristol Gp. 600nm SW Ascension. ETA TEZ 25 May
- (3) MCM Gp. 1400nm NE TEZ. ETA holding area 500nm ENE of TEZ 24 May.
- (4) Exeter. 900nm NE TEZ. ETA TEZ approx 23 May.
- (5) <u>Antelope/Ambuscade</u>. 750nm NE TEZ. ETA approx 25 May.
- (6) $\underline{\underline{Amphibious~Gp}}$. Remains outside Eastern edge of TEZ. No significant change.
- (7) <u>Battle Gp. Presumed operating Eastern edge</u> TEZ between Amphibious Gp and Falklands:
 - (a) Harriers from INVINCIBLE carried out high level bombing on suspected Argentine helo Operating Base in the vicinity of Two Sisters, $7\frac{1}{2}$ miles West of Port Stanley. Results not known due to very high cloud.
 - (b) INVINCIBLE RVd with HECLA at 191600Z for transfer of NARWAL Pow. HECLA to transfer Pow to UAGANDA in holding area.
 - (c) Loss of Sea King 4, press embargo.
- b. Submarines. Nil contacts
 - (1) Spartan. Moving inshore N of C Blano
 - (2) Valiant. Patrolling between Spartan and Falklands
 - (3) Conqueror. Remain NE of Falklands
 - (4) Splendid. Patrolling SW of Falklands
 - (5) Onyx. 1300 nm SW of Ascension
 - (6) Courageous. NW of Cap Verde.
- c. Air

(1) Nimrod. One 19 hour surface surveillance sortie supported by 9 Victor tankers, to 470 S closed to 150nm off Argentine Coast at medium level. Visual contact with a contrailing Boeing 707, 450nm North of Falklands. A second sortie within 400nm of Ascension located PRIMORYE class AGI 60nm South of Ascension. A third air test and cooperation sortie with BRISTOL also flown.
