ITEM 5 - HERCULES MINE-LAYING CAPABILITY

6. The paper at <u>FLAG J</u> is presented for discussion by the COS. The proposal looks sound, but I would have thought that such a capability could be mounted in less than 2 weeks. Is there an operational requirement for an aerial mine-laying capability? If so, where and when is the requirement?

ITEM 6 - AOB

7. The paper at <u>FLAG K</u> (Air Defence of Ascension Island), supported by CTF $3\overline{77}$ at <u>FLAG L</u>, might be raised under AOB because I understand that $\overline{ACDS}(Ops)$ has some reservations.
