THE FIRST SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT REACTION WAS TO REFUSE TO COMMENT. SUBSEQUENTLY IN RESPONSE TO OPPOSITION QUESTIONS ABOUT PRESS REPORTS OF SOUTH AFRICAN ARMS SUPPLIES TO ARGENTINA, THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE, GENERAL MAGNUS MALAN, LAST NIGHT (24 MAY) MADE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT IN PARLIAMENT:

BEGINS

I FEEL IT IS MY DUTY TO MAKE A SHORT STATEMENT THIS EVENING IN

IT IS GENERALLY KNOWN THAT IT IS OUR POLICY TO PROVIDE NO DETAILS ABOUT SOUTH AFRICA!S TRANSACTIONS IN ARMS, AMMUNITION AND OTHER MILITARY MATTERS. WITH REFERENCE TO TODAY!S SPECULATION I WILL

HOWEVER THIS EVENING ON THIS ONE OCCASION DEPART FROM THIS POLICY BECAUSE HE ARE HOW IMPLICATED IN A CONFLICT.

SOUTH AFRICA HAS NOT PROVIDED OR SOLD TO ARGENTINA ANY MISSILES OR AEROPLANE PARTS IN ANY MAY AS HAS BEEN REPORTED, BEFORE OR DURING THE FALKLANDS CONFLICT.

THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT HAS CONSISTENTLY DECLINED TO CONFIRM DR DENY ALLEGATIONS OF ARMS SUPPLIES TO AND FROM SOUTH AFRICA SOUTH AFRICAIS INTERESTS DEMAND THAT THIS PRINCIPLE SHOULD NOT BE VIOLATED. THE GOVERNMENT ACCORDINGLY ALSO DOES NOT CONFIRM OR DENY THE EXISTENCE OF ANY CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS WITH ANY SPECIFIC COUNTRY OR WITH ANY SPECIFIC AGENCY OF ANY COUNTRY IT SHOULD BE CLEAR TO ALL THAT SHOULD THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT BADERMINE THIS PRINCIPLE, A SITUATION HOULD EVENTUALLY ARISE WHERE PARTICULARS OF ARMS SUPPLIES TO AND FROM ALL OF THE COUNTRIES WITH WHICH SOUTH AFRICA HAS DEALINGS WOULD BE DISCLOSED, CAUSING INCALCULABLE HARM TO SOUTH AFRICA!S SECURITY. THE WHOLE QUESTION OF ARMS SALES IS AN EXTREMELY DELICATE ISSUE BASED UPON MUTUAL TRUST AND INTEGRITY CONTRACTUAL ARRANGEMENTS OF THIS NATURE CANNOT BE TAMPERED WITH WITHOUT OTHER COUNTRIES AND AGENCIES IN SUCH COUNTRIES QUESTIONING SOUTH AFRICAIS ABILITY TO ACT WITHIN THE SPIRIT OF THESE ARRANGE-MENTS.

THIS MORNING!S DIE BURGER (25 MAY) REPORTS THAT THE PRIME MINISTER, MR P W BOTHA, TOLD THE NEWSPAPER EARLIER YESTERDAY (ALSO BEFORE GENERAL MALANIS STATEMENT) THAT SOUTH AFRICA WAS GUIDED BY ITS OWN INTERESTS IN ARMS TRANSACTIONS. QUOTE THIS IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE POLICY WHICH HAS BEEN LAID DOWN SINCE I BECAME MINISTER OF DEFENCE AND WHEN AN ARMS EMBARGO WAS INTRODUCED AGAINST SOUTH AFRICA. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS POLICY SOUTH AFRICA DOES NOT SAY FROM WHOM SHE BUYS WEAPONS OR TO WHOM SHE SELLS THEM. ACCORDINGLY HE DO NOT ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HE HAVE SOLD NEAPONS TO ANYBODY, WE SHALL NOT BE FRIGHTENED OFF THIS POLICY BY POLITICKING. UNQUOTE.

5. IN RESPONSE TO FURTHER PRESS ENQUIRIES WE SHALL TAKE THE FOLLOWING LINE: QUOTE NE HAVE NOTED AND REPORTED TO LONDON GENERAL MALANIS STATEMENT THAT SOUTH AFRICA HAS NOT SUPPLIED ARGENTINA HITH MISSILES DR AIRCRAFT PARTS UNQUOTE.
