SELLAFIELD, ETC - 1 NOVEMBER

I spoke to Eric Huke, Department of Energy, about the programme for the Prime Minister's visit, attached to Mr Pilling's letter of 22 August. He will be taking up with BNFL the trade union and staff side meetings at each site, which look superfluous. He will also be raising the address, included on the programme for the Sellafield visit, and be proposing that this be linked with the unveiling of the plaque and kept informal. I made clear that there could be no question of the Prime Minister making a prepared, formal address to the staff.

I subsequently spoke to the CEGB about the Heysham visit. They are aware of the need to provide lunch and will be discussing the detailed programme with the Department of Energy.

Eric Huke will, in due course, be putting a complete, and amended, programme to us for approval. I explain that we should be looking to him to co-ordinate the visit as a whole.
