PRIME MINISTER'S VISIT TO KOREA AND ECONOMIC SUMMIT, TOKYO

1. PRIME MINISTER'S RAF VC10 WILL BE REFUELLING AT ANCHORAGE EN ROUTE TO SEOUL AND ON RETURN FROM TOKYO AS FOLLOWS (ALL TIMES LOCAL):

THURSDAY 1 MAY

ARRIVE ANCHORAGE 1815

DEPART ANCHORAGE 1945

TUESDAY 6 MAY

ARRIVE ANCHORAGE 1210

DEPART ANCHORAGE 1340

YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED SEPARATELY IF THERE ARE ANY CHANGES IN THESE TIMES.

2. ON OUTWARD TRIP PRIME MINISTER WILL BE ACCOMPANIED BY NO 10 PARTY AND MEMBERS OF PRESS: ON RETURN PRIME MINISTER, FOREIGN SECRETARY, CHANCELLOR OF THE EXCHEQUER AND MEMBERS OF THE UK DELEGATION BUT NO PRESS, WILL BE ABOARD AIRCRAFT.

3. THE PRIME MINISTER AND OTHER MINISTERS WILL WISH TO ACCOMPLISH THESE TRANSIT STOPS WITH THE MINIMUM OF FUSS. THEY WILL NOT NECESSARILY WISH TO LEAVE THE AIRCRAFT, BUT IF THEY AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE PARTY DO SO THEY WILL BE

4. PLEASE INFORM US AUTHORITIES OF THESE STOPOVERS. IF SOMEONE WILL BE AT THE AIRPORT TO GREET PRIME MINISTER (WHICH IS NOT NECESSARY) PLEASE WARN US IN ADVANCE.

5. PLEASE SEE MIFT FOR DETAILS OF SECRETARY OF STATE'S TRANSIT STOP EN ROUTE TO TOKYO. THE CHANCELLOR WILL NOT BE TRANSITING THE US EN ROUTE TO TOKYO.

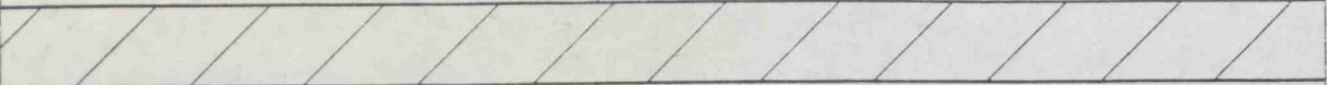
