TOKYO ECONOMIC SUMMIT

1. YOUR NOTE OF 8 APRIL REFERRED TO PM'S PREFERENCE FOR MALVERN OR HIGHLAND SPRING SPARKING WATER.
2. BRITISH NATURAL SPRING WATERS CANNOT BE IMPORTED INTO JAPAN UNLESS THEY ARE ABOVE A CERTAIN (HIGH) PRESSURE OR ARE HEAT-TREATED: THEY ARE THEREFORE DE FACTO EXCLUDED. SULLIVAN IN OT2/2 DTI, CAN GIVE YOU MORE DETAILS IF REQUIRED.
