2. Amplifying information:

Para 6. Survivors from ATLANTIC CONVEYOR are in BRITISH TAY. COVENTRY survivors are in STEAMERS for transfer to QE2. Whalerounds of ARBENT and ANTOLOPE survivors not known at this stage but could be in CANBECCA.

Land Ops. No further sitrep received.

3. It is understood (Circ Fleet 272241Z May) that Argentine Embassy in Montevideo has officially informed Uruguay Govt that UGANDA is being used to land troops and war material. Because of numbers of STL and length of time for Warg transfer, CONROW requested UGANDA enter Middle Bay to embark casualties, and was in the Bay from 271200Z to 271230Z. CTG does not intend to use her in this way again unless really necessary.

Land Ops

1. Following air raid last night, information available is limited. A full sitrep is hoped for by 0630Z. Land line with Brigade is broken. Only Teleprinter working.
2. Numerous Unexploded bombs are littered about.
3. Flares and machine gun fire were observed in Darwin/Goose Green area around 2200.
4. Casualties from bombing - 3 killed (one sergeant, 2 marines) 20 injured.
