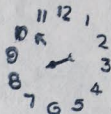

1. Sir A Parsons telephoned from UKMIS New York to say that he was sending a telegram overnight this evening giving an account of his talk with the UN Secretary-General today. In brief the telegram says that the Argentinians cannot accept our views and describe them as terms for 'surrender'. The Argentinians were more interested in fulfilling paragraph 4 of SCR 505 and wanted to know what we meant by 'international security arrangements' i.e. do we mean something on the lines of the Sinai MFO or a UN Force.

2. Perez de Cuellar will report to the Security Council on Monday 31 May. He asks if he may include in his report the message from the Secretary of State.

3. Sir A Parsons is going away to the country for a day (his first off since 23 March) to stay with Brian Urquhart. Until 8 pm Sunday New York time he can be reached at 413-2430542.
